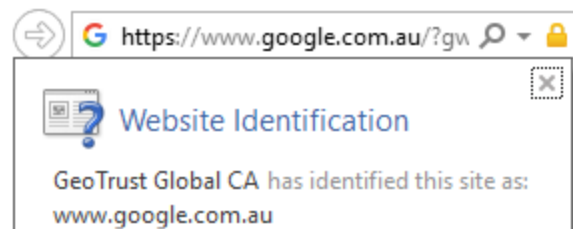

How to Tell a Website is Secure

If you need to enter personal or private information in a website, check to see if the URL in the address bar of your internet browser starts with "https://". The letter "s" is very important, since it signifies that the website

is encrypting data between your browser and the website. Web browsers represent HTTPS encryption with a lock icon (usually green) in the address bar, and confirms the website has a security certificate that matches the domain part of the website's URL. You can usually verify the certificate by clicking the lock icon in the address bar, which will display the certificate information.



Wifi Testing

A technician from our wifi installer will be onsite over the next week or so. He will be wandering around Rembrandt Court testing wifi coverage and will need to enter residents rooms as part of the testing.



Hand hygiene is the most effective ways of stopping the spread of infection. It is extremely important for everyone, especially our residents and clients as they are more susceptible to infection.

When you should wash your hands
