

MADRAS STREET RESURFACING ROAD CLOSURE

Thursday 25th and Friday 26th May 2023

Board Meeting

The Board meeting was held on Wednesday 3rd May 2023 at Rembrandt Court. Our Chair, Sef, is currently overseas touring and visiting his home town in the Netherlands and other countries. In his absence Marie Wood (Deputy Chair) oversaw the Board Meeting.

To upskill the Board, Director Marie Wood presented on Stakeholder Engagement. It was noted Stakeholder Engagement is already being conducted well through various Board Committees, (e.g. the Consumer Advisory Committee and Clinical Governance Committee) however there is always room for improvement. The CEO and Executive Team were tasked with developing a Stakeholder Engagement Framework to present to the Board.

The annual review of our Constitution was discussed and agreed there will be no changes required to the document for this year.

Home Care - it was announced that our Home Care team have achieved their target of 400 home care packages now, well before the end of the financial year. The Board acknowledged this achievement and congratulated the team.

With pleasure the CEO announced that Rembrandt have been selected as the preferred home care provider for the Woodbridge Retirement Village located in West Lakes. It is planned for dedicated Home Care Coordinators to be on site at Woodbridge to facilitate the residents' requests for in-home care and allied health requirements.

'Doreen Street' Land

Following receipt of an independent valuation, the Board unanimously voted to attempt purchase the land adjacent to Rembrandt Court from the South Australian Housing Authority and tasked the CEO to undertake the negotiation process.
