BOARD MATTERS - JUNE 2023

The Board meeting was held on Wednesday 7th June 2023 at Rembrandt Court. All Board members were in attendance with the Chair, Sef, having returned from his overseas holiday.

In the absence of the GM of Residential Care, the CEO presented to the Board on the Residential Star Ratings which was introduced in December 2022 and the improvement strategy on how we all can positively improve on the ratings. Rembrandt has maintained its 4 star rating for the past two quarters but are working on concepts for improvement to attain a 5 star rating.

During the month the CEO contacted the South Australian Housing Trust with an offer to purchase the Doreen Street land adjacent to Rembrandt. The Board is pleased to advise that this negotiation has now concluded and the Government has agreed to Rembrandt Living purchasing the land with a settlement period to be agreed upon. The Board discussed the various options open to the development of the land or in the interim to use as is.

The CEO advised the Board that Home Care now has three offices in metropolitan Adelaide, Southern Home Care office located at Rembrandt Court; Western Home Care office located within the Woodbridge Retirement Village; and with the proposed sale of the Greenfields site, the leasing of a suitable facility in the north eastern suburbs which is currently being investigated.

A major part of the discussions at the Board Meeting was around the Budget Assumptions and the 2023 / 2024 Draft Budget, taking into account culture and care needs, growth of the Home Care sector, and the Government advised wage increases for Aged Care workers. The Budget will be presented to the Board at its next meeting in July.

CYBER SECURITY AT REMBRANDT COURT

In recent weeks a National Australia Bank (NAB) customer living in Aged Care was the target of fraudsters, receiving an email and letter advising of a change of bank details for their aged care service provider. The letter asked the resident to pay a large deposit. Thankfully they contacted their service provider before making the payment and it worked out it was fraudulent.



According to the Australian Cyber Security Centre (ACSC), Australians are at risk from malicious actors using tactics such as phishing emails, ransomware attacks, online frauds and scams, data breaches and identity theft. These threats can be both financially costly and emotionally damaging for those affected by them. In 2022, there were nearly 76,000 reports of cybercrime in Australia. This marked an increase of 13% from the previous year. 30% of Australians have been victims of online fraud and scams over the past year
