The Board meeting was held on Wednesday 5th July 2023 at Rembrandt Court with all Board members in attendance excluding Etienne Scheepers who joined us via Zoom.

The annual Insurance Renewal was discussed and the Board elected to renew the Policy as was recommended and reviewed thoroughly by the Finance, Audit, Risk and Compliance Committee.

An inspection of one of the units at Doreen Street occurred during the month with a representative from Junction Australia. The appearance externally and internally was explained as indicative of the condition of all eight of the units, but with some minor maintenance, painting and a spruce up, the units will be able to be let once settlement has occurred and until a decision on the proposed development is made.

The future of the Green Fields Home Care site was discussed with a licensed valuation sought. The board noted that on 30 June 2023 the Dutch Club officially vacated the premises and handed over the keys of the building to Rembrandt Living.

The Board acknowledged and thanked the Dutch Club for the services they have provided to the South Australian Community for over 45 years.

The Home Care & Health Care Centre Main Hall has had a mini makeover and is now in use by our Home Care social groups, see photos below.
