The Board meeting was held on Wednesday 2nd August 2023 at Rembrandt Court with all Board members in attendance.

The CEO facilitated an Aged Care Awareness Activity which included a video of a staff member and a Resident. This activity was filmed during a dementia training session. We are well on our way to becoming a Teepa Snow accredited organisation.

An update was provided to the Board on various activities from the Strategic Plan Action Plan which are currently underway, including Focus Group meetings on Digital Transformation; a Cybersecurity Report and Star Ratings.

The General Manager, People and Culture (Fiona Rosman) presented to the Board on 'Strategic Workforce Plan Roadmap' framework which is designed to ensure Rembrandt Living continues to employ the best people for our organisation. It includes mentoring and training to upskill individuals as well as thinking outside the square in promoting innovative ideas in the approach to our future workforce.

The Board were advised there was no further updates in relation to the Doreen Street project.

Due to consistent growth, particularly in Home Care, the Board approved an increase to the credit card limit.

The future Board composition was discussed with the Chair advising of a number of Director's tenures being up for re-election this year, some of which are due to their tenure being over 10 years. The Board discussed this at length and wish to investigate some changes to the Constitution to be presented to Members at this year's AGM.

The Annual General Meeting date is set for Wednesday 15th November, at the Marion Hotel.
