## 2023 REFERENDUM VOTING AT REMBRANDT

We are pleased to advise that a Mobile Polling team will conduct polling at Rembrandt Court for the 2023 Referendum on the 6th October 2023, between 9:00am and 12:00pm. The Mobile Polling team can issue a vote to any elector who is enrolled in South Australia. If an elector is unable to vote with the Mobile Polling team during their visit, they can apply for a postal vote. Postal voting is available for anyone not able to make it to vote in-person, either on voting day or during the early voting period.

Postal vote applications will close at 6pm on Wednesday, 11th October 2023. To apply for a postal vote you will need to apply and complete the application form online at [www.aec.gov.au/pva](http://www.aec.gov.au/pva)

It is important to remember that voting is compulsory for anyone enrolled. Rembrandt Court has the official Referendum booklet and it can be provide to any voter who requests it. The booklet can also be downloaded by scanning the QR code below.

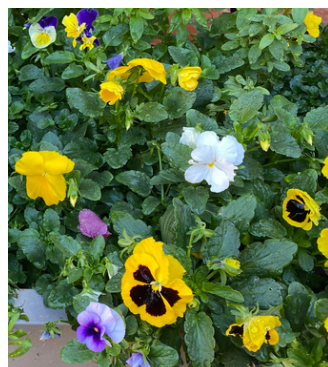

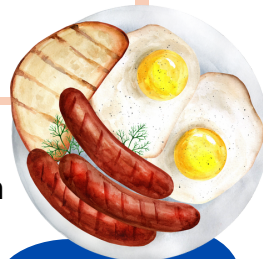
