REFERENDUM VOTING AT REMBRANDT COURT

Rembrandt Court will host a AEC Mobile Polling team and conduct polling for the 2023 Referendum on the 6th October 2023, between 9:00am and 12:00pm.



The Mobile Polling team can issue a vote to any elector who is enrolled in South Australia. If an elector is unable to vote with the Mobile Polling team during their visit, they can apply for a postal vote. Postal voting is available for anyone not able to make it to vote in-person, either on voting day or during the early voting period.

Postal vote applications will close at 6pm on Wednesday, 11th October 2023. To apply for a postal vote you will need to apply and complete the application form online at www.aec.gov.au/pva. It is important to remember that voting is compulsory for anyone enrolled. Rembrandt Court has the official Referendum booklet and it can be provide to any voter who requests it.
