

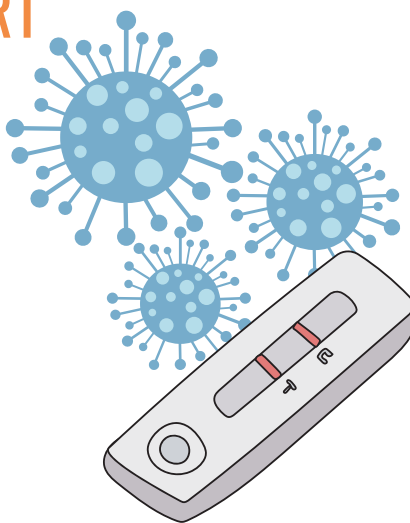

COVID AT REMBRANDT COURT

Unfortunately, we must advise that we have a COVID-19 outbreak at Rembrandt Court. At this stage, we have four residents (and two staff members) who have tested positive. These residents are all from Magnolia house. All of these Residents have only mild symptoms. Let's hope it does not spread any further.



Visitors are still allowed; however, N95 masks will be required for staff and visitors whilst in Magnolia house, and blue surgical masks will be required in all other areas. Staff are required to RAT test before every shift and visitors are encouraged to do so before visiting. Please remember to practice good infection control and monitor yourself for symptoms. If you develop symptoms, please get tested and stay away from our home as appropriate. For the time being we have temporarily ceased all cross house activities and are encouraging all residents to eat meals in their house dinning rooms where possible.

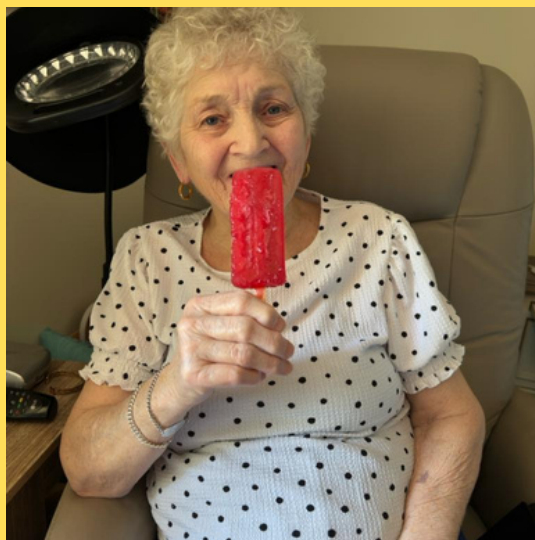
